

FESTIVITIES BEGIN

FRIDAY August 12th

Campers may begin arriving at 9am Friday, August 12th.

SATURDAY August 13th

Gate opens at 9AM. Music 11AM – 7:30PM.

WHAT TO BRING

Lawn chair and or blanket. Much of the terrain is sloped.

Cash to buy food and drinks.

Up in our mountains it can be cooler than expected. We suggest extra layers.

Trowel to dig in back legs of chair to make it level.

WHAT ARE THE RULES AND REGULATIONS?

DOGS ARE NOT ALLOWED IN THE CONDOS, ON-MOUNTAIN CAMPING OR AT THE FESTIVAL.

Coolers, sun umbrellas set up that block anyone's view, dogs, and video recording are prohibited in the concert area.

Wristbands must be worn at all times.

Alcoholic beverages are available and allowed only in the beer gardens.

NO Alcoholic beverages are allowed into the festival or enjoyed outside of the boundaries of the beer garden. (Maine Law)

Seating

Seating in the concert area is on a first-come, first-serve basis.

People will be able to set up chairs, put out blankets or small tarps (no larger than 6 x 8 feet).

The concert area will open at 1 PM on Friday and again at 9 AM on Saturday. Seats may be left overnight.

Dancing

We have a designated area near the stage for people to dance.

CAMPING INFORMATION

All camping is very rough.

Space is limited. Tents, campers and RVs are welcome. Everyone will be encouraged to take up as little space as necessary.

No electrical or water hook-ups. Portable toilets will be located in the parking lot and near the tenting location. There are also restroom facilities in the base lodge.

TENT CAMPING

Tents may set up in the parking lots or on the ski trails. The locations on the ski trails cannot be reached by vehicles, so be prepared to carry what you bring. Portable toilets will be located near the tenting location and the base lodge will be open to access the toilets inside.

WHO MAY CAMP?

Everyone is welcome who has a 2-day Festival ticket.

DO I NEED CAMPING RESERVATION?

We are not taking camping reservations. First-come, first-serve.

WHEN MAY I ARRIVE?

9a.m. on Friday the 12th.

WHAT DOES CAMPING COST?

\$10 for each tent and \$15 for each RV

WHEN IS CAMPING OVER?

Campers must be out by 5p.m. Sunday.

PUMPING STATION?

The Rangeley Lakes State park, 13 miles down the road, has a pumping station and charges \$5.

MAY I BRING MY DOG?

We are sorry but we do not allow dogs.

ICE

We will have ice for sale.

OTHER RULES:

No glass please

No outdoor fires. Contained cook fires such as propane cook stoves and hibachis are welcome. Bring a fire extinguisher.

IS PICKIN OK?

Absolutely, that is what it is all about.
