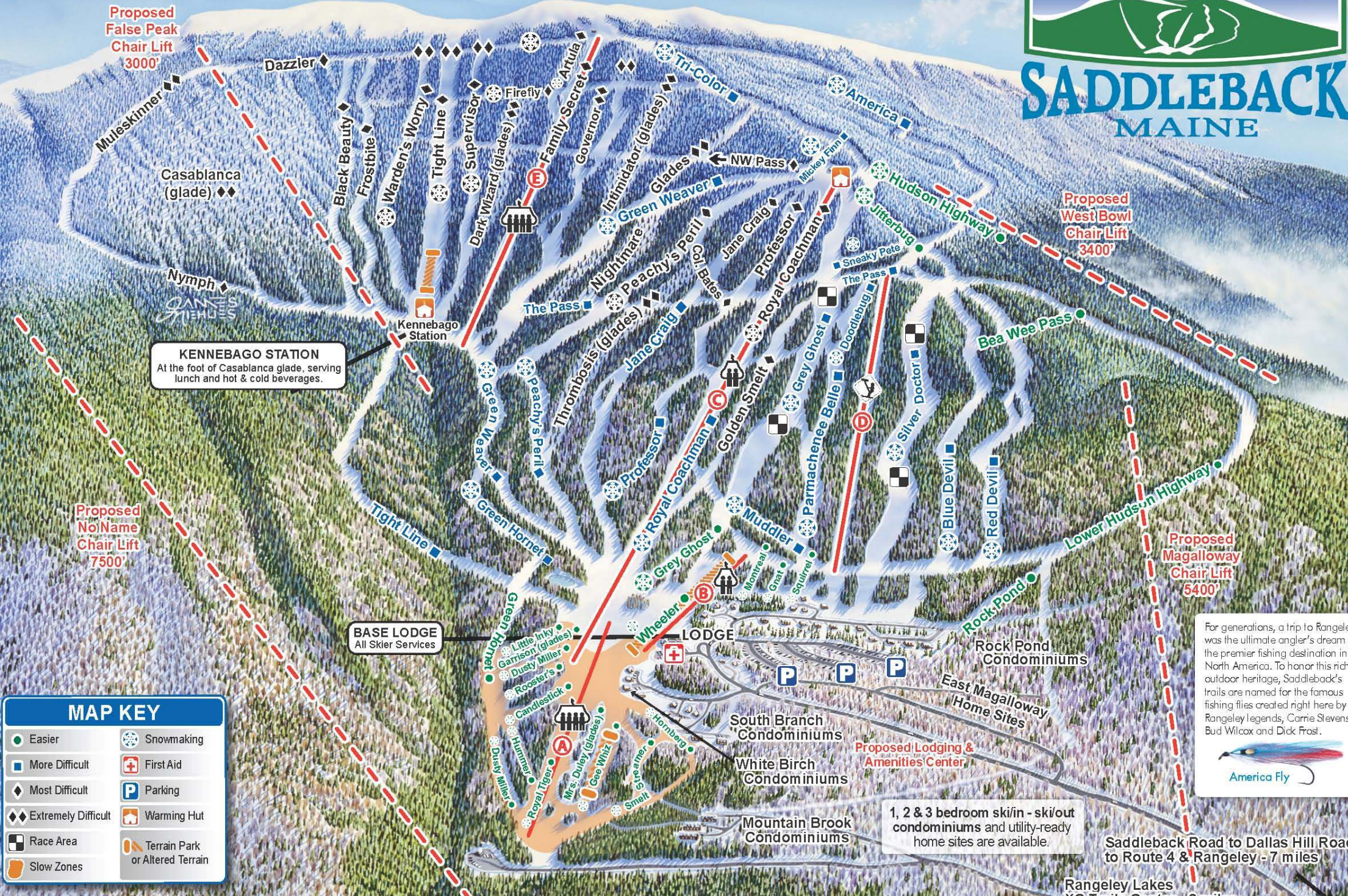
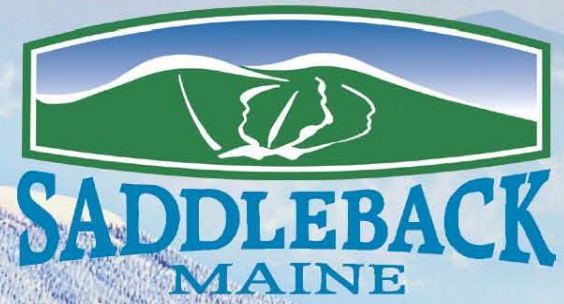


**Saddleback Mountain**
