



## **Rules & Regulations for Saddleback Bike Park**

**No on mountain rescue service available outside of lift operating hours.**

**All users of the bike park and trails are required to purchase a ticket or season pass and complete the release of liability form. Any person under the age of 18 must have a parent/legal guardian present to sign a mountain bike release of liability form.**

- Helmets are required for all riders. Full-faced helmets are strongly recommended.
- Closed-toe shoes are required.
- All bikes are required to have front and rear working brakes. Disk brakes are recommended.
- All users age 10 and under must always be accompanied by an adult or legal guardian while utilizing the bike park.
- Do not ride if you are under the influence of drugs or alcohol.
- Uphill riding is only allowed on the designated uphill trail "Don's Delight."
- Dogs are not permitted on bike trails, on a leash, or otherwise.
- ATVs, trucks, heavy machinery, and maintenance personnel may be encountered at any time. Use caution and yield.
- Please be advised that any equipment that does not fit properly on bike carriers will not be allowed on the lift.
- Unauthorized drones are not allowed anywhere in or around the bike park.
- For everyone's safety, the lift may close at any time for inclement weather. The lift will go on a 30 min hold each time thunder and/or lightning is present. Seek shelter during lightning storms.
- Please respect the environment and area that we provide the services within –follow the 'leave no trace' rule and carry out all trash.
